### **INTERNSHIP**

### **Minimum requirements:**

- Must be able to write in both Afrikaans and English
- Must be a student with UNISA or another reputable organization (must study teaching in the intermediate and/or senior phase)
- If you are not already a student with UNISA or another reputable organization, then you must apply and be accepted (your contract and appointment with the school will depend on this).
- Minimum qualification: Matric
- Must be able to manage your time extremely well
- Must be able to work well with various personalities
- Must be able to work well with learners of various ages
- Must be able to work well under pressure
- Must be able to meet deadlines
- Must always have a neat and tidy appearance
- Must be an excellent role model for the learners
- Must be willing to put in extra hours after the school day has ended as well as over a week-end, if required

You will be asked to attend an interview where members of the intermediate and/or senior phase as well as members of the senior management team will ask you questions based on the abovementioned criteria.

The contract will run for a year. The option to renew the contract will be available if the school feels that the appointed candidate has met the necessary criteria and proved to be a valuable member of the BD's team.

There will be a 3-month probation period before the school makes the decision to extend the internship to a year.

# Tasks will include:

- Class assistant: helping to mark books, teaching, any other classroom admin
- Coaching of various sport (Monday to Saturday): rugby, hockey, cricket, athletics
- Being available after hours to coach, umpire/referee matches, assist with functions, etc.
- Driving the school minibus
- Being available to assist and to travel along on sport tours, school camps, etc.
- Be able to assist the head of sport with various activities
- Maintaining the use and standard of sporting equipment
- Assisting with sport inventory
